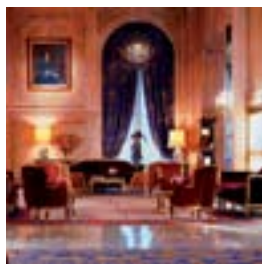

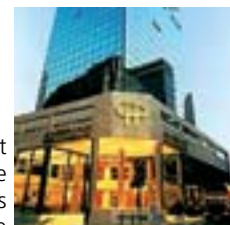

Iguazú Falls - The roaring waters

3 days/2 nights

Pre-conference tour: Thursday 9 – Saturday 11 October

Post-conference tour: Saturday 18 – Monday 20 October

Visit one of the true wonders of the natural world featuring 275 individual cascades plunging over 90 metres into the river below stretching over three kilometres and across three countries. Their semi-circle formation creates a natural amphitheatre that is a truly amazing spectacle. The Iguazú National Park surrounds the falls, comprising 65,000 hectares of tropical jungle with thousands of species of plants and hundreds of wildlife species including tapirs, monkeys and alligators. Paths, stairways, bridges and balconies enable visitors to feel the spray from the falls which were discovered in 1541 by the Spanish explorer Alvar Nuñez Cabeza de Vaca. Nearby are the Jesuit mission ruins established during the 18th century and whose European influence on the local people is still evident today.

Day 1:

Transfer from Puerto Iguazú airport to the International Sheraton Hotel within the Iguazú National Park. There is then a half-day excursion to the Brazilian National Park, * where colourful butterflies, and rainbows created by the spray from the thundering water, fill the air. Starting at Das Cataratas Hotel, participants will set off on an hour-long walk to the Devil's Throat canyon before returning to the International Sheraton Hotel.

***Please note:** consult with your nearest Brazilian Embassy or Consulate to determine whether you require a visa to enter Brazil.

Day 2:

A full-day excursion to the Argentinean side of the falls, where visitors have time to engage in the following choice of activities:

Upper walk (45 minutes): A 500-metre walk to elevated viewing points for several of the cascades.

Lower path (90 minutes): A 1,300-metre walk along a footpath led by a professional guide, with unique views from the middle of the falls; you may well get wet!

Devil's Throat: A 4-kilometre train ride to Devil's Throat station on the upper part of the Iguazú River. Cross a bridge (walkway) that leads to the balcony of Devil's Throat for dramatic views.

Great adventure (60 minutes): A trip through the rainforest of the National Park in open-top 4 x 4 trucks, perfect for picture taking. This is followed by an upstream motorboat ride on the lower Iguazú River with panoramic views of the falls, ending with a shower under the falls!

Day 3:

Early breakfast followed by a half-day excursion to the indigenous jungle of the Iguazú Forest to discover the secrets of this virgin jungle. It is the only place in the country where participants can engage in activities such as the 'Special canopy', which involves swinging between treetops in a bird-like fashion, suspended from equipment similar to a cable car. Experienced instructors will be on hand providing safety instructions and equipment. Transfer to Puerto Iguazú airport to return to Buenos Aires.

World-renowned for its magnificent natural scenery and the traditional colonial towns where time seems to have stopped, this area gives visitors the opportunity to go back to the time of colonisation.

The area is an important centre for unique master crafts such as tapestries; textiles; sheep, llama or alpaca-wool ponchos; gold and silver works; and baskets.

Day 1: Salta – Cachi

Arrival at Salta airport and transfer to the Calchaquíes Valleys where one can enjoy the beautiful mountain scenery. We will pass through several quaint villages including Payogasta, an old Indian village,

and Molinos, a mid-17th century town with traditional adobe (mudbrick) houses and unique panoramic views. From here, the steep road leads to Cachi, a beautiful town of colonial aristocracy with impressive white buildings where time appears to have stood still. Stay overnight in Finca Bodega Colome.

Day 2: Cachi – Cafayate – Salta

After breakfast we will head south, passing through San Carlos and arriving at Cafayate, capital of the Calchaquíes Valleys. While this sandy valley is most famous for producing traditional wines, it is worthwhile visiting the cathedral with its unique architecture, or the nearby picturesque stone mill. After lunch visit one of the wineries where the famous Malbec and Torrontes wines are produced in this dry, humid climate. Enjoy stunning sunset views as we return to Salta and stay overnight at the Solar de la Plaza Hotel (www.solardelaplaza.com.ar)

Day 3: Salta – Purmamarca

After breakfast we head to Tilcara, a town of low, adobe (mudbrick) buildings, steep streets, magnificent views and abundant archaeological features, before stopping for lunch in Uquia. In the afternoon we will visit the UNESCO world heritage site of Quebrada de Humahuaca, an enormous gorge cut deep into the desert countryside.

Thereafter we head to Purmamarca, a pre-Hispanic district famous for its Cerro de Siete Colores (Hill of Seven Colours). Well-maintained cobbled streets are lined with a collection of pretty mud houses and churches. The most famous of these churches is the picturesque Santa Rosa chapel which has been declared a National Historical Monument. Its simple architecture of mud walls and clay roof, constructed in 1648, defines the style of the entire village. We will stay overnight at Manantial del Silencio Hotel (www.hotelmanantial.com.ar)

Day 4: Salta

We return to Salta, where participants will have a free afternoon before they transfer to Salta airport and return to Buenos Aires. Salta is a city rich in Hispanic architecture and centuries-old monuments.

The pretty traditional alpine city of San Carlos de Bariloche, is located in the heart of the Nahuel Huapi National Park, on the crystal clear shores of the lake. The city, originally founded by immigrants from the European Alps, combines the quiet of nature with the pace of a city. The local architecture is of stone and timber construction, and the specialities of cheese and chocolate fondues continue the alpine heritage.

Located in the core of the Patagonian mountain range within two national parks, surrounded by lakes, rivers and an ancient forest is the town of Villa La Angostura. This small town was established during the 19th century and is surrounded by the lower slopes of the mountains where one can enjoy hiking and mountain bike riding.

One of the greatest attractions of the area is the walk along the Quetrihué Peninsula, which leads to the Los Arrayanes Forest, renowned for its old trees of more than 20 metres high.

Meet at Jorge Newbery airport to fly to Ushuaia. Stay at the Las Hayas Hotel with incredible views of Ushuaia Bay (www.lashayashotel.com).

Half-day catamaran cruise along the Beagle Channel, named after Captain Fitzroy's ship, HMS Beagle, which connects the Atlantic and Pacific Oceans. Cruise up to the Les Eclaireurs lighthouse and around Sea Wolf Island, where a large population of seals and sea lions live. The catamaran allows visitors to get within close proximity of the sea birds, offering excellent photo opportunities. Lunch is on board the boats. Return to Ushuaia.

After breakfast, an excursion to the Tierra del Fuego National Park, a scenic area of bare beaches, plunging waterfalls and glacier

The city of Mendoza is known as the 'Eden of the Andes' and is surrounded by low-lying desert hills at the foot of the jagged pre-Andean mountain ranges. Originally inhabited by the indigenous Incas, Huarpes and Puelches people, before the arrival of the Spanish conquerors, the Huarpes were a group who lived on the 'Valle de Huentota', where Mendoza city is located today. They spent their days farming, hunting and fishing, and became especially skilled in making pottery and baskets, including a design unique to South America for storing liquids. The city of Mendoza is better known for the ingenious irrigation system established by Captain Don Pedro del Castillo who founded the city in 1561. This system transports water from the Mendoza River to fields of maize, beans, and pumpkin, converting 'The Sands Land' (as the indigenous tribes called it) to the oasis that it is today.

Day 1: Buenos Aires/Mendoza

Arrive at Plumerillo airport. Transfer to the Hotel Executive where you will stay for three nights (www.parksuites.com.ar). Afternoon city tour of Mendoza. Welcome dinner and overnight stay in the hotel.

On the Península Valdés, the wilderness of the nearly deserted east Patagonian landscape contrasts with its incredible abundance of fauna: whales, sea lions and elephant seals, guanacos, ñandúes (American ostriches), penguins, gulls, cormorants and countless other species of birds.

Day 1: Buenos Aires/Península Valdés

Transfer from Trelew airport to the Hotel Territorio (www.hotelterritorio.com.ar). Overnight in hotel.

Day 2: Península Valdés

Early departure for Puerto Pirámide, named after the nearby cliffs that resemble Egypt's Valley of the Kings. Here we board a whale-watching boat and head to the south of the peninsula and keep a look out for the ocean's mammals and bird life.

Around midday we arrive at Punta Delgada and have lunch in the El Faro resort, where steep cliffs separate the hotel from the colony of sea elephants on the beaches below. Visitors will have the opportunity to view the animals up close.

Then we journey along the coast of the peninsula, stopping at Caleta Valdés and look out for penguins, egrets, cormorants, and the endangered southern elephant seals. We then head inland to the Ameghino reserve, home to wild land animals such as guanacos, rheas, foxes, maras (Patagonian hares), armadillos and skunks. Return to Puerto Madryn at sunset.

Day 3: Punta Tombo

Today we will visit the large penguin colony at the Punta Tombo provincial reserve. Around two million penguins gather here from September to April in order to mate, incubate their eggs and feed their young. At Rawson Port, passengers will be able to go skunk-dolphin watching, before continuing to the Welsh town of Gaiman. Here tour guides explain both the history of the settlement and the typical building styles in the colony. You cannot leave the town without stopping at a tea house for a cup of Welsh tea.

We will take a city tour of Trelew with an optional visit to the Palaeontology Museum housing dinosaur skeletons' pre-historic fossils. Once again we return to Puerto Madryn at sunset.
